The position will involve: (a) research/scholarship in a substantive area related to school psychology or child and adolescent psychology, (b) graduate teaching in areas of expertise, (c) supervision of doctoral research and (d) related program responsibilities.

Applicants with graduate teaching and advising, school-based experience and a strong record of research productivity and potential for external funding are sought. Priority will be given to those with scholarship and expertise in addressing the needs of culturally and linguistically diverse youth in school and clinical settings. Specifically, research focused on culturally-responsive practices; promoting equity and reducing educational and mental health disparities, evidence-based academic and behavioral interventions; and system-wide prevention and intervention models is preferred. Ferkauf encourages applications from women, Black, Indigenous, People of Color (BIPOC), protected persons and others committed to a diverse community that expands our teaching and research mission. The candidate should be a licensed psychologist or license eligible in New York State.

The School-Clinical Child Program is an APA-accredited and NASP-approved Doctor of Psychology Program.
