## **CAFTR JOURNAL CLUB: NOVEMBER MEETING**

In this meeting, we will discuss two papers that draw on data collected from the Depression Online Therapy Study (DOTS), a small pilot study conducted at the Anna Freud Centre in 2019. The study examined the acceptability and preliminary effectiveness of a psychodynamic online treatment for adolescent depression, which was first designed and evaluated in Sweden by Dr. Karin Lindqvist and Dr. Jakob Mechler.

Dr. Rose Mortimer's paper examines transcripts of therapy "text-chat" sessions to explore the features of therapeutic alliance in text-based interactions. Dr. Liat Leibovich's paper explores how therapists' use of various techniques (psychodynamic, cognitive/behavioural, common factors) predict symptom improvement in subsequent sessions.

We are hoping you will participate and share your thoughts about this innovative and exciting area of research!

Dr. Liat Leibovich is a licensed clinical psychologist and supervisor in Israel. Her research focuses on change mechanisms in psychodynamic psychotherapy. Today Liat works at the "Ahava" children's village and is responsible for the clinical internship program there. She also works in private practice and teaches at the "Mifrasim" institute.



Dr. Rose Mortimer is a researcher in the Child Attachment and Psychological Therapies unit at the Anna Freud Centre, and a trainee clinical psychologist at University College London. Rose completed her Ph.D. in Bioethics at Oxford University in 2015. Her research focuses on themes across psychodynamic psychotherapy, parenting, child mental health, attachment, and mentalization.



Malenka Areas is a Ph.D student at Universidad de Buenos Aires, Argentina. Her research focuses on themes across Child and Adolescent Psychotherapy, Adolescents with Depression, and Interpersonal style.
