## Overview

IMPACT Psychological Services is a thriving group practice, specializing in integrative psychotherapy, offers postdoctoral fellowship positions in Mamaroneck, NY and Beacon, NY. Our postdoctoral fellows work with children, adolescents, and adults, including psychotherapy and psychoeducational testing and assessment. We offer many unique opportunities and a wonderful environment, with supportive, expert supervisors with specialties in psychodynamic psychotherapy, CBT, DBT, attachment-based therapies, and family systems models. We invite applications for full-time postdoctoral positions that begin in Fall 2025. We offer a competitive pay structure, weekly didactics, multiple forms of supervision, and a warm, collaborative work environment.



## Program Features

- Develop greater generalist skills in integrative psychotherapy across the lifespan and deepen expertise in a range of areas: child/adolescent work, trauma-informed psychotherapy, DBT for adolescents, therapeutic assessment, working with clients across the LGBTQIA+ spectrum, neurodiversity-affirming approaches and much more.
- Receive weekly individual and group supervision, and participate in didactics, a weekly staff meeting, group testing/assessment supervision, and our DBT-A Consultation Team with the IMPACT staff.
- Psychoeducational testing and personality assessment (including projectives) are core, required components of the postdoctoral fellowship.
- Training and certification in asylum assessments through the Physicians for Human Rights. Trainees will have the opportunity to conduct asylum assessments under supervision.
- Guidance for creating your own private practice upon completion of the postdoctoral fellowship.
- A family-friendly environment with supportive parental leave policies, dental/vision/life insurance provided at no cost to the fellow, and a monthly stipend which can be used to offset the cost of health insurance.
- This is an outstanding and unique opportunity for psychologists who are interested in working in a private practice setting with youth and adults in consultation with a warm and supportive team.



## Qualifications

- Applicants must be New York State limited permit-eligible graduates of an APA-accredited program with a strong interest in integrative psychotherapy and experience with psychodynamic and CBT treatment modalities.
- Training in child and adolescent psychotherapy is required; prior experience with adults is ideal and candidates must be interested in working with adults.
- Successful candidates are flexible, independent, collaborative, and have strong critical thinking skills. Must be able to work effectively as part of a clinical team.
- Experience working with a diverse population of patients in terms of presenting problems, multicultural identities, and sexuality and gender.
