Aim

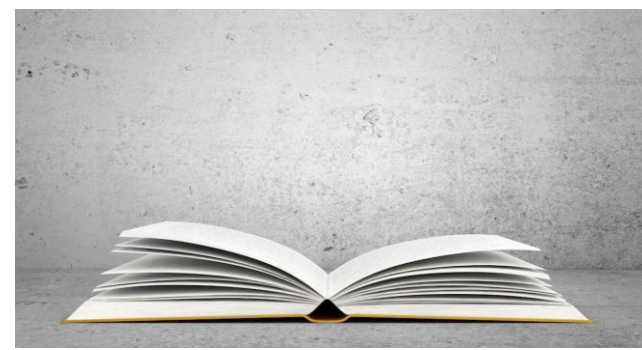
- Support and promote research in the field of child and family therapy
